

EMERGENCY ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF PEARL RIVER COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Having previously declared that a local disaster and emergency exists in Pearl River County, Mississippi, by virtue of the coronavirus "COVID-19" the Board hereby incorporates by reference Executive Orders 1457, 1458, 1459, 1460 & 1461 previously entered by Tate Reeves, Governor of the State of Mississippi, and all other proclamations or executive orders entered by the President of the United States, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the Mississippi State Department of Health, the U.S. Center for Disease Control, and the cities of Poplarville and Picayune, Mississippi; and

HEREBY FINDS the hereinabove above stated resolutions and facts constitute a local emergency within the meaning of §19-11-21 of the Miss. Code of 1972 Ann. caused by epidemic and immediate preservation of public health is necessary; and

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (1) All restaurants and bars suspend on premises services until further notice. Drive-through, curbside and delivery options are available for restaurants.
- (2) All persons heed all warnings and directives from the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Mississippi State Department of Health.
- (3) All persons practice social distancing and self quarantine for your health and safety and that of others.
- (4) Social gatherings will be limited to no more than ten (10) persons exercising social distancing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND RESOLVED that all citizens and businesses within Pearl River County, Mississippi, should comply with said orders and any recommendations of the Governor of the State of Mississippi, Mississippi State Health Department, President of the United States, U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services, and U.S. Center for Disease Control now existing or enacted in the future to preserve and protect the health and welfare of the citizens of Pearl River County, Mississippi.
